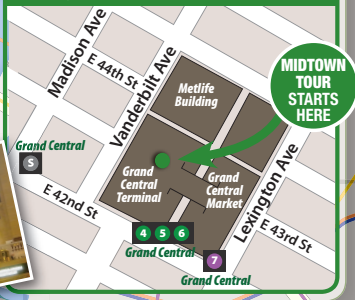

- 1 **Brandy's Piano Bar (C1) - \$\$\$**
A fantastic place to catch live music – the pianists take requests written on napkins!
- 2 **Carmine's (B2) - \$\$**
Quality Italian food in the Midtown district. The portions are generous and the steak Contadina is to die for.
- 3 **Fat Cat (A4) - \$**
This pool hall/jazz club has a classic sultry NYC atmosphere. Other games on offer include ping pong, foosball, shuffleboard, even chess.
- 4 **The Grey Dog (B3) - \$\$\$**
Fuel up for a day in the city with the excellent breakfasts and brunches here. Rustic décor, friendly service makes this a local's favorite. Many gluten-free options available.
- 5 **The Halal Guys (B2) - \$**
Legendary food truck selling famously good falafel, chicken and lamb. Don't be put off by the line, it moves quickly. But do beware the hot sauce; it's not for the faint-hearted!
- 6 **Jimmy's Corner (B2) - \$**
This inexpensive sports bar in Midtown is a perfect place to watch sports with diehard fans. The boxing memorabilia is just amazing.
- 7 **Junior's Restaurant (B2) - \$\$**
Locals love this classic diner for a casual and satisfying bite to eat. They have everything from ribs to cheesecake.
- 8 **Los Tacos No. 1 (A3) - \$**
Mexican food is a must if you want to eat like a New Yorker! The tacos here are arguably some of the best in town.
- 9 **Motorino (B4) - \$**
This typical New York pizza parlor does delicious, no-frills food. Great choice and speedy service.
- 10 **Otto's Shrunken Head (B4) - \$\$**
You'll have a blast in this kitsch Tiki-themed dive bar! Keep your kooky cocktail glass for just \$5 extra!
- 11 **Prosperity Dumpling (B5) - \$**
Chinese dumplings are the latest food trend, not to be missed and, at four dumplings for \$1, it's a bargain too!
- 12 **Upstate (B4) - \$\$\$**
Enjoy NYC's ocean connection in this acclaimed seafood restaurant. This is the perfect place to get your oyster fix.
